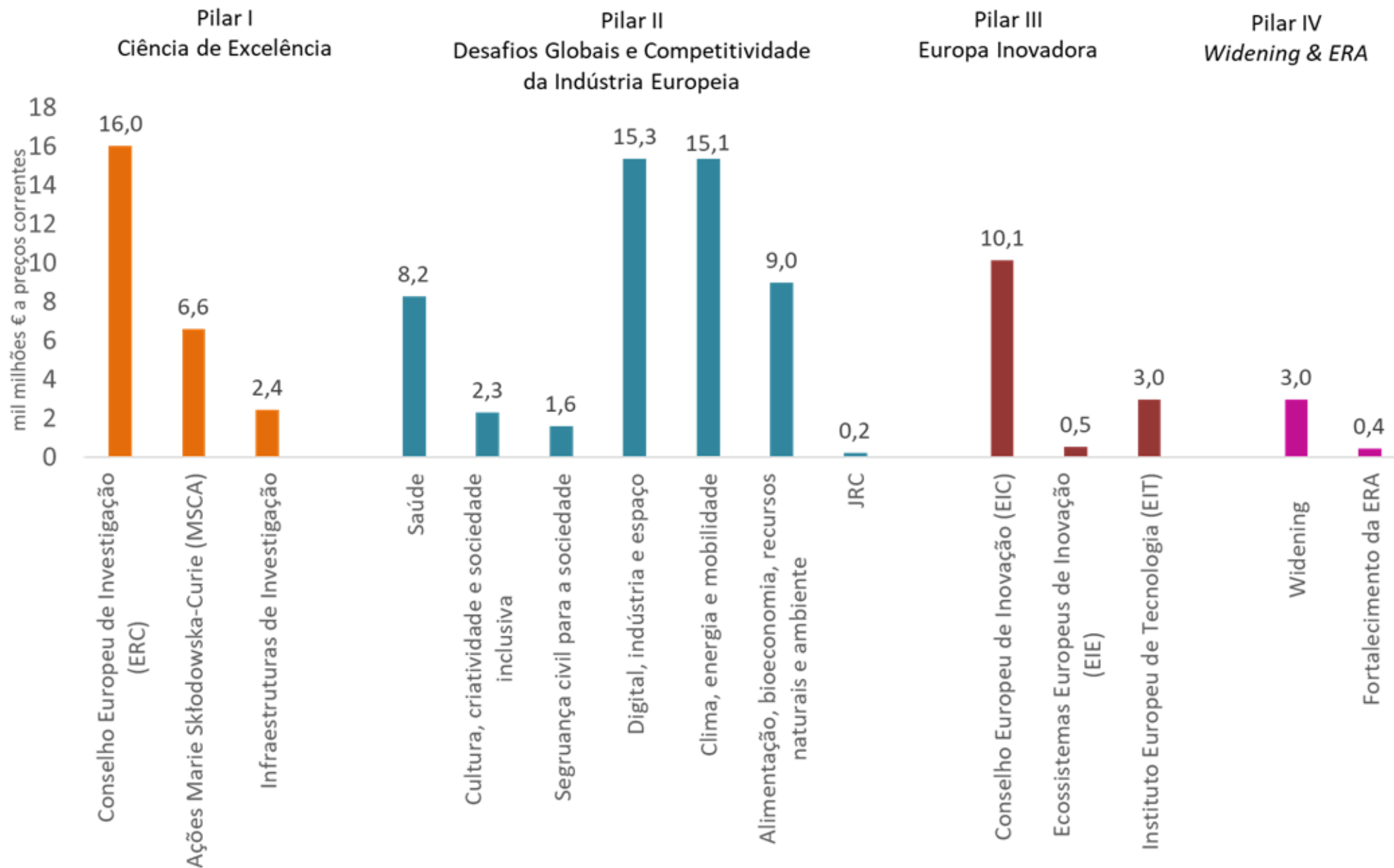

| | EXPECTED OUTCOMES = TOPICS | Expected effects of the projects supported under a given topic, fostered by the dissemination and exploitation measures. This may include the uptake, diffusion, deployment, and/or use of the project results by target groups. |
| | PROJECT RESULTS | What is generated during the project implementation e.g. know-how, innovative solutions, algorithms, proof of feasibility, new business models, policy recommendations, prototypes, demonstrators, datasets, trained researchers, new infrastructures, networks, etc. |

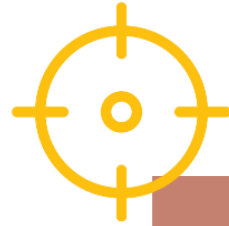

European Partnerships

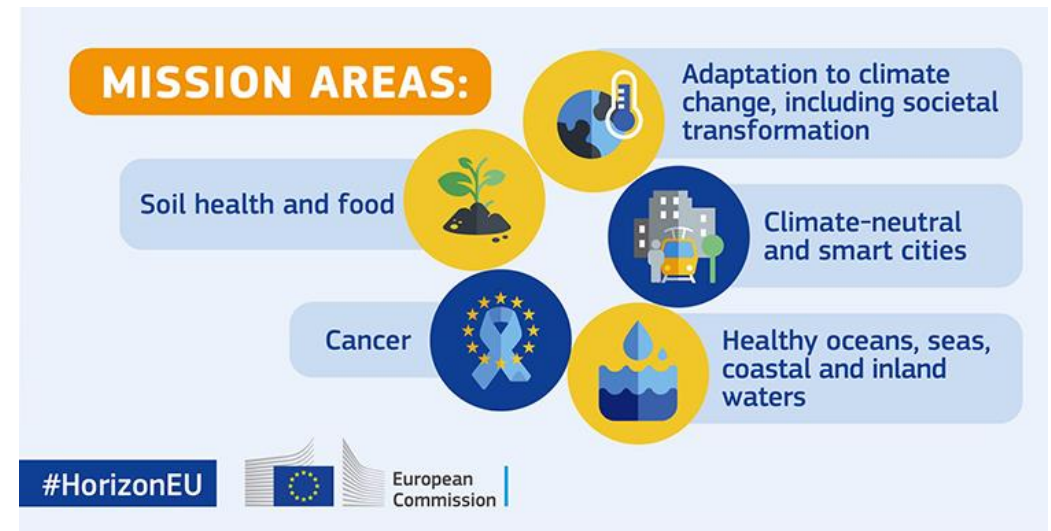

Horizon Europe (2021-2027)

New Approach to European Partnerships in HE (~50% of Pillar II budget)

New generation of objective-driven and more ambitious partnerships in support of agreed EU policy objectives

Key features

- **Simple architecture and toolbox**
- **Coherent life-cycle approach**
- **Strategic orientation**

Co-programmed

Based on Memoranda of Understanding / contractual arrangements; implemented independently by the partners and by Horizon Europe

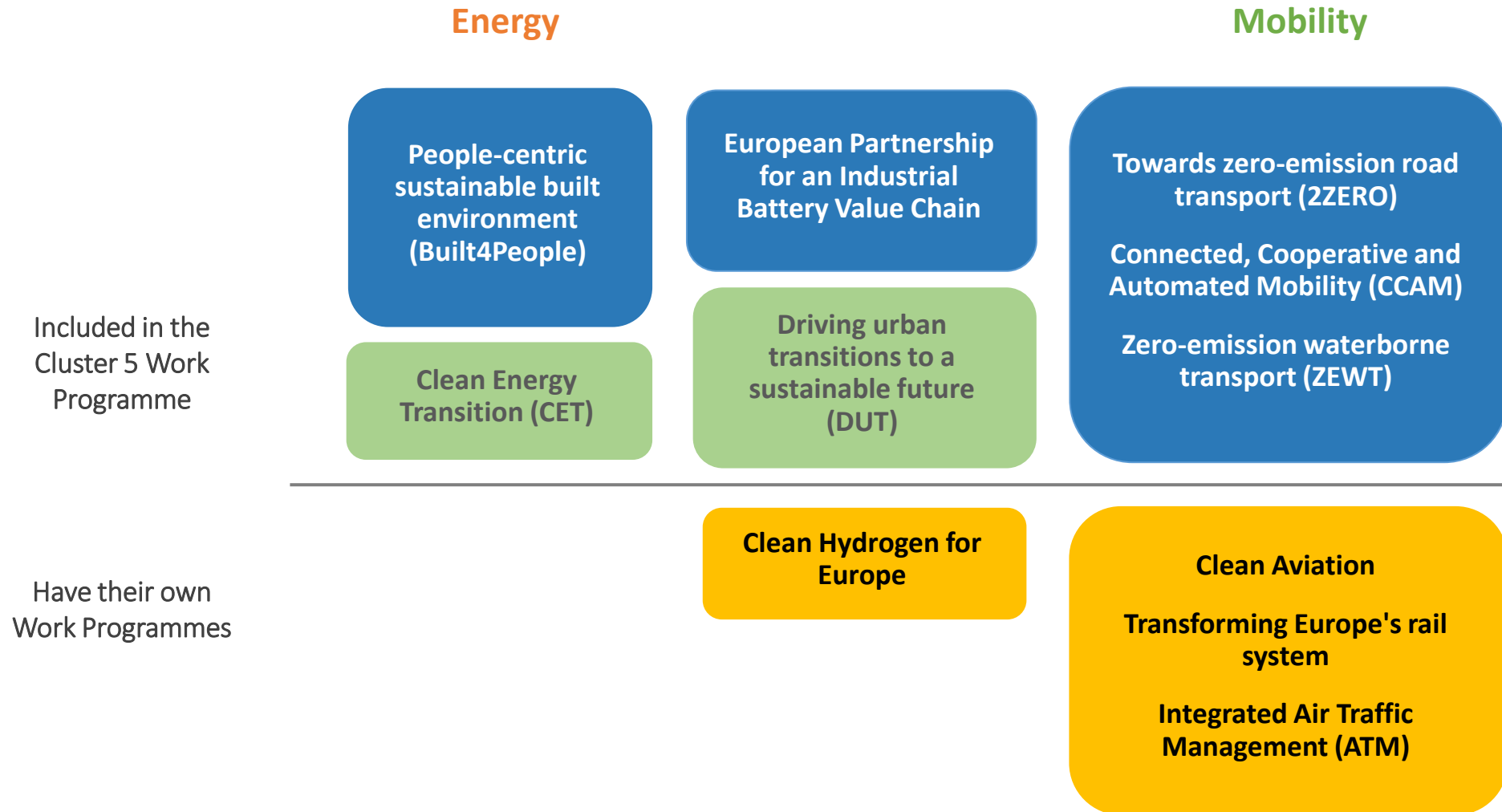
Co-funded

Based on a joint programme agreed and implemented by partners; commitment of partners for financial and in-kind contributions

Institutionalised

Based on long-term dimension and need for high integration; partnerships based on Articles 185 / 187 of TFEU and the EIT-Regulation supported by Horizon Europe

Mariya Gabriel, Commissioner for Innovation, Research, Culture, Education and Youth said:

“These Partnerships are all about pooling research and innovation resources and ensuring that research results are turned into useful innovations for the citizens. With Horizon Europe we are committed to emerge from the climate crisis, provide sustainable solutions to major environmental challenges, improve citizens’ health and accelerate a sustainable recovery. This will benefit all Europeans.”

Single Basic Act (SBA) – Lays out the framework for Institutionalized Partnerships

During the 1st semester of 2022:

- The partnerships should create/update their websites
- There should be significant activity in the next weeks/months with:
 - Publication of the first Work Programmes
 - Clarification of the rules for applicants, etc.
 - Publication of Calls for Associate Members (*when applicable*)
 - **To be informed, it is important to subscribe to their newsletters**



Lessons learned/Tips

- **SUBMIT** a (next to) final version of your proposal **SEVERAL DAYS BEFORE THE DEADLINE!**
- **AVOID** editing (your part of) the proposal with **MORE THAN ONE USER** from your organisation at the same time!
- **DO NOT** edit the proposal in **MORE THAN ONE BROWSER TAB/WINDOW** at the same time!
- **SAVE** your changes **FREQUENTLY!** No data is saved until you click on **SAVE**.
- **DO NOT USE** file names containing **SPECIAL CHARACTERS** for files you upload. Only alphanumerical characters: A-Z, a-z, 0-9, _ (underscore), - (dash), . (dot) or space are allowed.
- **DO NOT ENCRYPT** or **DIGITALLY SIGN** your PDF files.
- **DOUBLE-CHECK AFTER UPLOAD** of files whether they can be opened without problems.
- **USE “VALIDATE”** button before submitting.
