

# HORIZON 2020



- **EU research and innovation funding programme** (2014-2020) with a budget over €70 billion (79 billion in current prices including inflation)
- A single programme bringing together three separate programmes/initiatives\*
- Coupling research to innovation from research to retail, all forms of innovation
- Focus on societal challenges facing EU society, e.g. health, clean energy and transport, raw materials
- **Simplified access**, for all companies, universities, institutes in all EU countries and beyond
  - \* The 7<sup>th</sup> Research Framework Programme (FP7), innovation aspects of Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme (CIP), EU contribution to the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT)

# 1. A single set of rules for all funding under Horizon 2020

• Fewer, more flexible, funding instruments

### 2. Simpler reimbursement: 1 project = 1 funding rate

- 100% of the total eligible costs (70% for innovation actions)
- Non-profit legal entities can also receive 100% in innovation actions
- Single flat rate for indirect costs (25% of eligible costs)

### 3. Faster time to grant

Within 8 months of call deadline







# 4. Fewer, better targeted controls and audits

## **5.** Coherent implementation

- Through dedicated agencies
- Single IT system

# 6. Simplification in grant agreements

**FRC** frontier Research actions >> only EXCELLENCE
**Innovation actions** >> higher weighting for "IMPACT"

Proposal evaluated by the experts "as it is" and not as "what could be" = no need for negotiation





- Single entry point from calls to electronic submission of proposals
- New tools for smart searches for the benefit of users, including newcomers to the programme.

# Societal Challenge 5



**Objective of Societal Challenge 5** : "to achieve a resource – and water – efficient and climate change resilient economy and society, the protection and sustainable management of natural resources and ecosystems, and a **sustainable supply and use of raw materials**, in order to meet the needs of a growing global population within the sustainable limits of the planet's natural resources and eco-systems"
