






Results per country: Top 13 countries





Mistakes to avoid and main issues



Grants overview – ineligibility

In 2021: 230 grants received

√ 0 Inadmissible

√ 23 Ineligible

√ 204 Evaluated



Main reason for ineligibility: Not complying with the general eligibility criteria



Main mistakes

- ➤ Not studying and analysing the topic text in advance no cross-check with the topic
- > Not depicting a clear picture of the problem that you're adressing
- ➢ Being too ambicious have concrete and achievable goals! goals must be coherent with the expected results, expected outcomes and impacts.
- Lack of alignment with relevant EU policies



Main mistakes

- ➤ Not answering to what the topic calls for not being specific enough
- Adding to much unrelated information that does not contribute to the resolution of problem presented by the topic
- Not specifying the long term impact of the project and the results uptake strategy
- Not adequately explaining complementarity in the consortium and each partner's role
