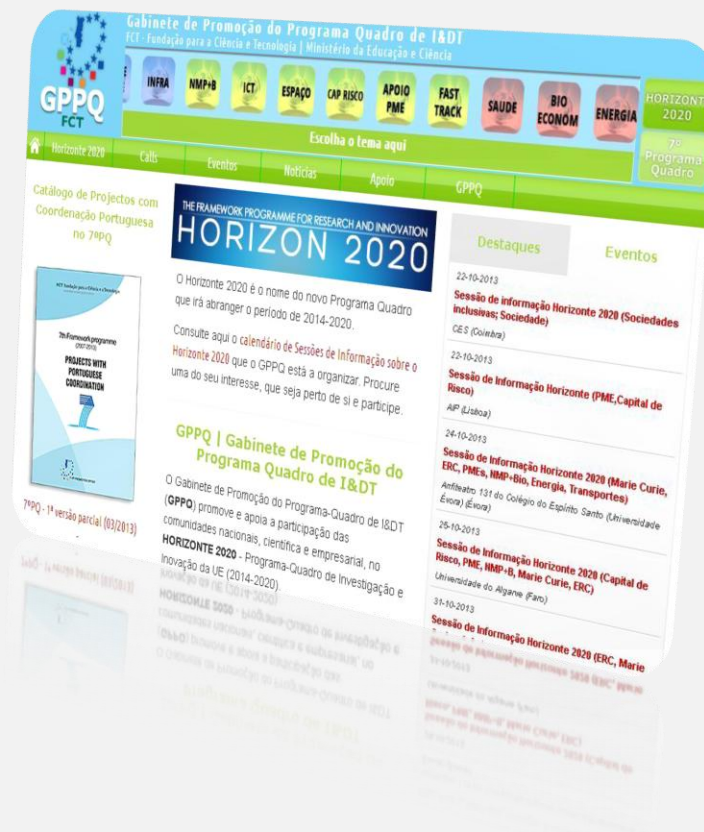

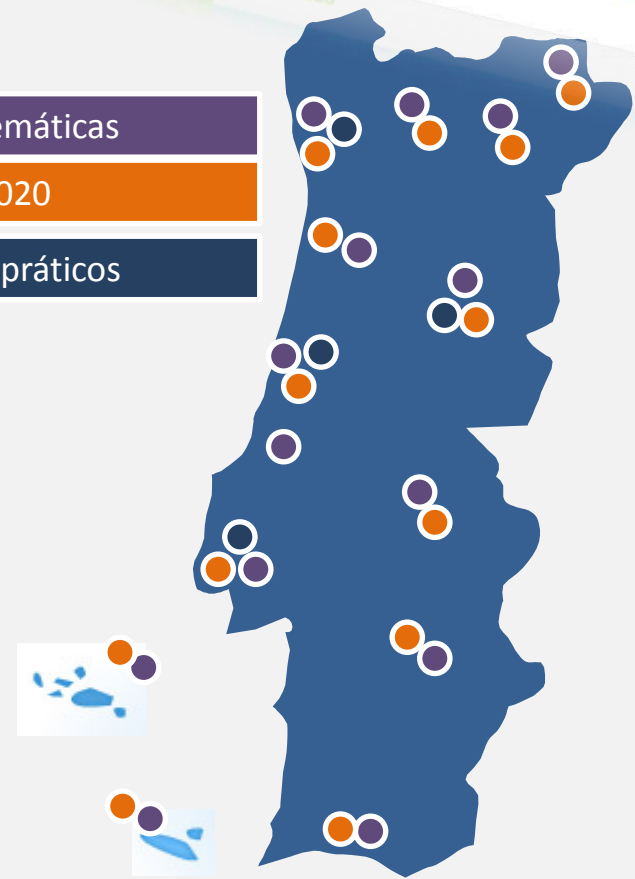

**ABSTRACT** *Project Objectives & Description of Work*

AGROBIOFILM's mission focuses on developing an innovative generation mulch film from biodegradable raw materials, subject complete composting when in contact with microorganisms found in the environment mostly in the soil. These materials are specifically adapted to the various types of culture, in order to respond to environmental needs, to reduce costs and to optimize resources.

The AGROBIOFILM project aimed at developing an alternative solution to traditional mulch (polyethylene), to test it on strawberries, melon, pepper cultures, and to adapt them to other similar cultures. The project also wished to test the new film on vines as an innovative alternative.

**PROJECT RESULTS**

The main results obtained were:

- Mulch film produced from a new formulation of Water-Bio® (CF) adapted for the different cultures and edapho-climate conditions being studied;
- The compostable Mulch film resulted in the same yield as polyethylene mulch;
- results in the vineyard showed a three-fold increase of vegetable expression;
- Recycle incorporation: sustainable and economic product with modification of mulch's rheological characteristics.



#### SME Instrument

The SME instrument has been designed specifically for **single or groups of highly innovative SMEs** with international ambitions, determined to turn strong, innovative business ideas into winners on the market. The instrument provides **full-cycle business innovation support** from the stage of business idea conception and planning (phase I) over business plan execution and demonstration (phase II) to commercialisation (phase III). Participants will be able to call on business innovation coaching for the duration of their project.

- **Phase I (proof-of-concept):** Explore the scientific or technical feasibility and commercial potential of your new idea in order to develop an innovation project, with the help of a € 50,000 grant, and receive more support in case of a positive outcome!
- **Phase II (development & demonstration):** Develop your sound, ground-breaking business idea further with the help of a grant in the order of € 500,000 to 2,5 million into a market-ready product, service or process!
- **Phase III (go-to-market):** Take advantage of additional EU support to enter the market successfully (no grants).

**Specific challenge:** To engage small and medium enterprises in space research and development, especially those not traditionally involved in it and reduce as much as possible the entry barriers to SMEs for Horizon 2020 funding.

The specific challenge of the actions envisaged under this call could cover any aspect of the Specific Programme for Space (Horizon 2020 Framework programme and Specific programme). However, it is considered that actions in the areas of applications, especially in connection to the flagship programmes Galileo and Copernicus, spinning-in (i.e. application of terrestrial solutions to challenges in space) and the development of certain critical technologies could be adequately suited for this call.

**Scope:** The SME instrument consists of three separate phases and a coaching and mentoring service for beneficiaries. Participants can apply to phase 1 with a view to applying to phase 2 at a later date, or directly to phase 2.

**In phase 1,** a feasibility study shall be developed verifying the technological/practical as well as economic viability of an innovation idea/concept with considerable novelty to the industry sector in which it is presented (new products, processes, design, services and technologies or new market applications of existing technologies). The activities could, for example, comprise risk assessment, market study, user involvement, Intellectual Property (IP) management, innovation strategy development, partner search, feasibility of concept and the like to establish a solid high-potential innovation proposal aligned to the enterprise strategy and with a European dimension.
