

#### European Research Council (ERC) Grants: A success story

- $\checkmark$  Highly recognized by the research community
- Over 5000 top researchers funded (celebration on 16 Jun)
- Growing number of articles in scientific journals and prizes
- ✓ Highly competitive (success rate ~10%)
- ✓ Efficient and fast grant management
- ✓ Eleven Nobel Prize Laureates







#### **ERC Grants – Work Programme 2016**



Eligibility in WP 2016... -Time reference: January 2016 -Extensions

- Maternity (18 Months) and Paternity (documented number of days)
- Long-term illness (90 days), clinical training or national service







### ✓ The PI may be of any age and nationality

- Research must be conducted in a public or private research organization (Host Institution/HI) located in one of the EU Member States or Associate Countries
- ✓ Portability

Research teams: PI + additional team members
 (6 members average)

✓ it is <u>neither a network</u>, <u>nor a 'research consortium'</u>







#### **ERC Grants – What research can be funded?**

### Any field of research

#### But ERC expects...

- ✓ Proposals of an *interdisciplinary nature*
- ✓ Pioneering proposals addressing <u>new and emerging fields of</u> <u>research</u>
- ✓ Proposals introducing <u>unconventional</u>, <u>innovative approaches</u> <u>and scientific inventions</u>
- ✓ Research with a <u>high-gain/high-risk pioneering projects</u>









✓ Up to € 1.5 million (in some circumstances up to € 2 million) (100% direct costs + 25% indirect costs)

Pls expected to spend a minimum 50% of their total working time on the ERC project and a minimum of 50% of their total working time in an EU Member State or Associated Country







#### the PI must...

- Have shown the <u>potential</u> for research independence and evidence of maturity - at least <u>one</u> important publication <u>without</u> the participation of their PhD supervisor
- Promising track-record of early achievements appropriate to their research field and career stage (eg. Up to 5 publications major international peer-reviewed multi-disciplinary scientific journals <u>and/or</u> in the leading international peer-reviewed journals, peer-reviewed conferences proceedings <u>and/or</u> monographs)







✓ Up to € 2 million (in some circumstances up to € 2.75 million) (100% direct costs + 25% indirect costs)

Pls expected to spend a minimum 50% of their total working time on the ERC project and a minimum of 50% of their total working time in an EU Member State or Associated Country







#### the PI must...

✓ Have shown <u>research Independence</u> and evidence of <u>research maturity</u>. e.g.: **several** important publications without the participation of their PhD supervisor

Promising track-record of early achievements
 appropriate to their research field and career stage (eg. Up to 10 publications in major international peer-reviewed multi-disciplinary scientific journals and/or in the leading international peer-reviewed journals, peer-reviewed conferences proceedings and/or monographs)







- ✓ Up to € 2.5 million per grant (in some circumstances up to € 3.5 million per grant)(100% direct costs + 25% indirect costs)
- Pls expected to spend a minimum 30% of their total working time on the ERC project and a minimum of 50% of their total working time in an <u>EU Member</u>
   State or Associated Country







#### the PI must...

✓ Be scientifically independent and have a recent research track-record and profile (last 10 years) which identifies them <u>as leaders in their respective field(s) of research</u>


✓ 10 years Track-record of early achievements (eg. <u>Up to ten</u> <u>representative publications</u>, as main author (or joint author) in major international peer-reviewed multi-disciplinary scientific journals <u>and/or</u> in the leading international peer-reviewed journals and peer-reviewed conferences proceedings of their respective research fields, also indicating the number of citations (excluding self-citations) they have attracted)

#### **Restrictions to Submission**

- ✓ PIs may submit proposals to different ERC grant calls under the same WP, but only the first eligible proposal will be evaluated;
- ✓ A PI whose proposal was evaluated as category C in the StG, CoG or AdG calls for proposals under WP 2014 or 2015 <u>may not</u> submit a proposal WP 2016;
- ✓ A PI whose proposal was evaluated as category B at step 2 in the StG, CoG or AdG calls for proposals under WP 2015 may submit a proposal WP 2016;
- ✓ A PI whose proposal was evaluated as category B at step 1 in the StG, CoG d AdG calls for proposals under WP 2015 may not submit a proposal WP 2016;
- ✓ New restrictions on applications to PI whose proposals have been rejected on grounds of breach of research integrity









#### **Restrictions to Submission**

- A researcher may participate as PI in only one ERC frontier research project at any one time;
- The PI of an ERC project may not submit a proposal for another ERC grant, unless the existing project ends no more than two years after the call deadline;
- A PI who is Panel Member for a 2016 ERC call or who served as a Panel Member for a 2014 ERC call may not apply to a 2016 ERC call for the same type of grant.







#### ERC Grants - Before you apply ask yourself...

- Does my idea fit ERC?
- Is this the right time to apply?



- Do I have the time to build a strong, competitive proposal?
- Who can help me?

#### ERC Grants – Prepare your proposal

- ✓ Get informed!
- ✓ Understand how evaluation works
- ✓ Prepare your proposal in advance:
- ✓ Make your writing clear and reader-friendly
- ✓ Write a strong abstract
- ✓ Know your budget...
- ✓ Get a strong and balanced B1
- $\checkmark$  Ask your colleagues/friends to read your proposal
- ✓ Ask us at GPPQ to read your proposal!
