#### SEF - FRONTEX PARTNER - NFPOC ROLE

Centralizes at national level all information flow related to the activities of Frontex (Joint Operations, Pilot Projects, Training, Conferences, Workshops, technical projects, etc).

The NFPOC was established on SEF and is the link between Frontex and all national authorities with responsibilities in the area of integrated management of external borders (SEF, Autoridade Marítima, FAP, GNR, PSP e Marinha).

Coordinates the national deployments within the Frontex joint operations – SEF.

Manage national pools of technical equipment and human resources, via OPERA (Operational resources management system).



### SEF - FRONTEX PARTNER - NFPOC ROLE


Analysis and granting of applications for access to various Frontex computing platforms, such as: **FOSS** (Frontex One Stop Shop documentation repository, related to the various Agency Areas), **Jora** (Joint Operations Reporting Application - reporting system of all operations) and **V-Aula** (e-learning platform of the Training Unit).

In partnership with Frontex – organization of meetings, workshops, roadshows, operations in Portugal (EPN; AFIC, Lusitania, All-in-one - air borders, Vega Children, Alexis I and II ...).

Managing the PT participation and intervention, in internal and external meetings, seminars, conferences, operations related to the area of respective responsibility - special reference to the participation in working groups within Frontex.

#### FRONTEX - ROLE IN IBM

Whereas the regular monitoring of the EU's external border remains the sole responsibility of Member States, the role of Frontex is focused on coordinating the deployment of additional technical experts and equipment for the areas of external border, with significant irregular migration pressure.


Frontex also reinforces the capacity of Member States with regard to training and exchange of good practices.

The Frontex joint operations are planned and developed, based on an annual risk analysis, which analyzes the risk probabilities in terms of illegal immigration and cross-border crime, along the EU's external borders.

According to this risk analysis the Agency establishes priorities, for joint operations in order to ensure effective operational response.
















### OPERATIONAL AREA JO POSEIDON SEA - 2015
