


Key scenarios - Global Annual GHG emissions





The 2015 Paris agreement

- On 22 April 2016, 174 countries signed the agreement in New York
- with 5-year strengthening:
 - $\,\circ\,$ stock taking 2018 / new INDC 2020
 - stock taking 2023 / new INDC 2025
 - 0 ...
- Biennial reporting & peer review
- Financial support for adaptation & mitigation (100 bn\$/year)




