
INTRODUCTION

- Climate-KIC is one of the first three Knowledge & Innovation Communities (KICs)
- Created in 2010 by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT)
- The EIT is an EU body whose mission is to create sustainable growth
- Climate-KIC supports this mission by addressing climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Climate-KIC brings innovation to market quickly by working with partners from across Europe – something they couldn't do on their own






Timeline of Events 2017




Climathon is a global 24hour climate change event organised by Climate-KIC which takes place simultaneously in major cities around the world.

Pathfinder Calls (Ideator)

Opens 3 times a year to Climate-KIC partners

> Financing up to 50kEUR (15-30 kEUR expected) – needs 25% of co-financing available

Projects with less than 6 months

- Aims to identify climate-relevant Innovation
 Opportunities with corresponding market needs.
- Pathfinder projects are funded by Climate-KIC to support our Partner community in both the development and refinement of ideas (supply-side) and the identification of a market need and proposition (demandside).



Demonstrator Calls

Eligibility Criteria Opens twice a year to At least 2 Climate-Climate-KIC partners Open to Climate-KIC geographies **KIC** partners need to be involved Financing between 200-800kEUR per Co-financing of at Innovation with a year least 50% validated Business Model necessary Projects with 2 to 3 years KIC partners submitting a Demonstrator Proposal need to agree in duration principle that, in case of a successful project, Climate-KIC may benefit from e.g. a share of the revenue generated or of the equity



Scaler – What is it?





Scaler Calls

•The Climate-KIC Scaler Programme **supports tried and tested innovations** in growing to achieve greater overall climate mitigation and adaptation impact.

Climate-KIC offers scaling services through both itself and also its community of Partners.

Our Partners therefore have the opportunity to offer their scaling services as part of the Scaler Programme capacity and also to benefit from scaling support of their innovations.



1. Scaler Instruments

The tools, networks, knowledge, competencies and intellectual property (the "capacity") through which innovations can be scaled.

2. Scaler Opportunities

The innovations that require Climate-KIC support, whether delivered by Climate-KIC or through its Partners, in order to scale.


