- Single flat rate for indirect costs: 25%
- No time sheet requirement for full time staff on a project
- Successful applicants to get working more quickly: reduction of average time to grant






Portuguese Participation (2014-2017)







PT PARTICIPATION: FP6 \rightarrow H2020







National Funding by Type of Entity



Sucess rate by proposal







Who should apply?

High growth, highly innovative SMEs with global ambitions that want to disrupt the established value networks and existing markets.





PHASE1

Concept & feasibility study Idea to concept The European Union will provide €50 000 in funding

Get results in 2 months and funding in 4 months



PHASE2

Demonstration, market replication, R&D and product development

Concept to Market-Maturity

The EU may contribute 70% of total project cost, between €0.5 and €2.5 million*

Get results in 4 months and get funding in 8 months

BUSINESS SUPPORT for market launch

Participants at both phases will receive world-class **coaching** benefit from **networking opportunities** with top level investors and potential partners and get support to **launch their product** on European and international markets.

- Phase 2 10 Jan, 14 Mar, 23 May, 10 Oct 2018

- "for innovators with ground-breaking concepts that could shape new markets. Only the most convincing and excellent proposals can be funded after a evaluation by technology, business and finance experts."
- No topics
- TRL6 or higher just in Phase 2
- New evaluation criteria and new templates
- Threshold is 13
- Interviews for phase 2

Fast Track to Innovation

Is a fully-bottom-up measure promoting close-to-the-market innovation activities that is open to all types of participants.

reduce the time from idea to market





Requirements

- Consortia: 3 to 5 entities
- The majority are companies or 60% of the budget is for companies
- Market take-up: 3 Years
- TRL 6 to 8
- Projects of 1 to 3M€
- 70% Funding
- 3 cut-offs: 21 Feb, 1 Jun, 23 Oct 2018
- Proposals have to include a business plan










Science and technology research by consortia exploring novel ideas for radically new future technologies that challenge current paradigms and venture into the unknown.


