### **ERA-MIN 2**

- Title: Implement a European-wide coordination of research and innovation programmes on Raw Materials to strengthen the Industry competitiveness and the shift to a circular economy
- Funding scheme: Horizon 2020 ERA-NET Cofund (SC5-17-2016)
- Total costs: 16 million Euro
- EU contribution: 5 million Euro
- Duration: **60 months** (1<sup>st</sup> December 2016 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021)
- **21** public research and innovation **funding organisations** (Ministries and funding agencies) from **17** countries/regions

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Secure the sustainable and responsible industrial supply of raw materials in support of the EU integrated strategy "Raw Materials Initiative" (2008) and the European Innovation Partnership on Raw Materials
- Enhance and strengthen the synergies, coordination and collaboration of public research and innovation (R&I) funding programmes from EU and non-EU countries and regions
- Support and promote R&I cooperation in the area of non-energy nonagricultural raw materials (construction, industrial and metallic minerals)







#### **OBJECTIVES**

- Improve the efficiency and impact of human and financial investment in R&I activities to strengthen the industry competitiveness and the shift to a circular economy.
- Reduce the fragmentation of R&I funding across Europe and globally through the implementation of 3 joint calls for transnational R&I proposals.



30 R&I projects 30 million Euro







## **Main activities**

- 2017 one Joint Call for R&I projects with EU co-funding
- **2018 and 2019** —two Joint Calls for transnational R&I proposals (*without EC co-funding*) OPEN to participation of funding organisations from other countries and regions
- **2018-2021** Follow-up of funded projects (including ERA-MIN projects). Organise mid-term and final Workshops







### **ERA-MIN Joint Call 2017**

- Joint Call for R&I projects with EU co-funding by 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017.
   Total Call budget including EU co-funding: 15 million Euro
- Call topics based on the challenges and priorities identified in the ERA-MIN Research Agenda (2013) that support the transition to a circular economy
- Centralised peer-review by Scientific Evaluation Board based on 3 main evaluation criteria: Excellence, Impact and Implementation.
- Selection of projects following the **ranking list** recommended by the Scientific Evaluation Panel.





- > Joint application & evaluation but national/regional funding
- National and regional priorities apply not all topics are supported by all funding organisations
- > Funding rules and regulations apply:
  - eligible partners from academia, industry, SMEs, NGOs, public authorities from the participating countries/regions
  - > Eligible type of research: fundamental and applied research (Technology Readiness Level TRL 1-9)







- ➤ **Partnerships academia-industry** are particularly encouraged to apply. Other types of consortia (e.g. purely industrial or academic) may also apply.
- Consortia of 2-7 partners from 2-7 countries (Minimum 2 EU Member States or Associated Countries) participating in the call
- > Average total project requested funding: 0.3 -1 million Euro
- > Project duration: between 12 and 36 months.
