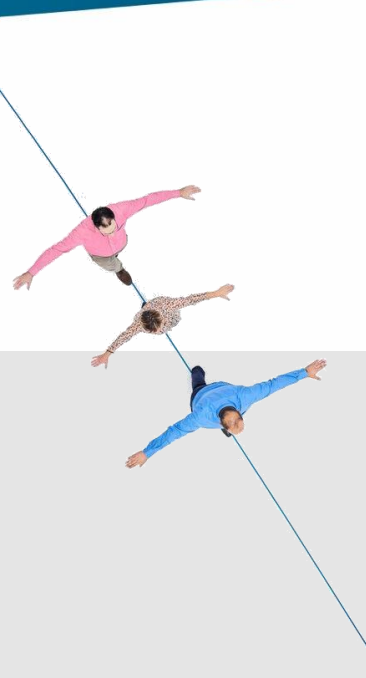

- Supporting Portuguese companies in alignment with EU policies in terms of energy, ecodesign,

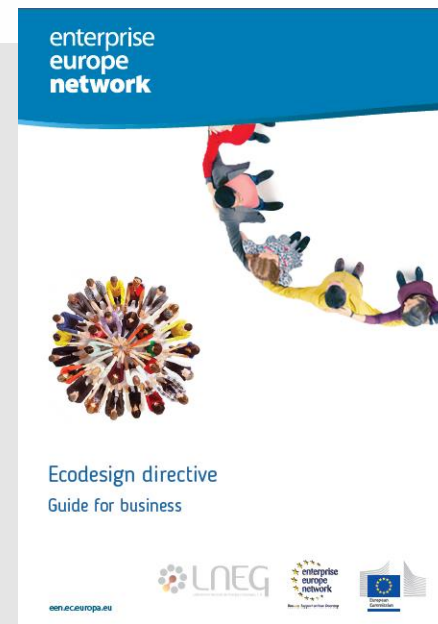
